

| <p>Causes</p> | <p>Once upon a time...</p> | <p>The Europeans valued new/ exciting goods (like spices, silk, etc) from Asia and other places</p> | <p>- <i>Image of spices with hands surrounding it</i></p>  |
| | <p>Every day...</p> | <p>- <i>Europeans used land trade routes which were dangerous and expensive</i></p> <p>They would use land trade routes to get the goods (such as the Silk Road), which were dangerous and expensive</p> | <p>- <i>map of Silk Road with images of Europeans in front of it (medieval style artwork)</i></p>  |
| <p>Historical Event</p> | <p>But, one day...</p> | <p>- <i>Portuguese began using the ocean/water as trade routes (became wealthy); Europe became aware/curious of exploration</i></p> <p>- <i>Americas were "discovered"</i></p> <p>The Europeans (more particularly, the Portuguese) began looking towards the ocean for trade routes. The Portuguese became wealthy from their new trade route to India by water, and the rest of Europe became aware/curious of exploration which lead to the "discovery" of the Americas</p> | <p>- <i>Caravel on water</i></p>  |

| | <p>Because of that...</p> | <p>- Americas were "colonized"</p> <p>The Americas were "colonized" by the Europeans; they gained wealth from the new goods that were taken back home</p> | <p>- Christopher Columbus in front of Americas with ships and goods (rough example below)</p> <p>- OR Christopher Columbus in front of America</p>  |
| | <p>Because of that...</p> | <p>- Europeans brought their own things/inventions/goods/diseases to the Americas</p> <p>The Europeans brought their own things to the Americas, such as foods (coffee, sugar, various grains, etc) and animals (pigs, cows, horses, etc). They also brought things they were not aware of, like disease, which decimated the indigenous population</p> | <p>- Image of overlapped (sugar, coffee, animals, disease *skull*)</p>  |
| | <p>Because of that...</p> | <p>- Europeans developed plantation system; used slavery</p> <p>The Europeans began to take people from their homes and developed a "plantation system" which was reliant on slavery</p> | <p>- Chains</p>  |
