Lannie has shared her work through workshops, lectures and publications with local, national and international audiences across North America, Europe, New Zealand and Australia.

Her Topic: Living Intensely

The feelings of highly able students are often amplified so they experience events in their lives with greater intensity and sensitivity. These feelings are essential to their development. Understanding them and accepting their role in personal growth provides powerful insights on the ways in which they are similar to and different from others their age.

Conversation and Connections

Parenting a gifted child brings with it special joys but also special challenges. As a part of this evening, members of the *Gifted Children's Association* of BC *(GCA)*, will be in attendance to meet participants and share information about this province-wide parent support group. GCA, a support group of parents for parents, works to establish local organizations across the province.
