ACTIVITY/TASK: Reading Sample using Book Creator App










LEARNING OUTCOME: Participants will learn how to create a reading sample with a model reader, student examples, mark up and review using Book Creator and the Camera Roll. Book Creator is a FREE app for one book \$ 5.79 for full version.

Before you begin you will need a photo of a page or pages of the book you are reading. Use the Camera app to take a photo and crop the page image in the photos app.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED: Book Creator Photo of a book taken with Camera app and cropped with Photos app



<p>1</p>	<p>Before you begin take a photo using the camera app of the page of the book you will be reading.</p> <p>Choose a low tech book or an Accessible Book or an eBook from one of the following sites or apps;</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Interactive eBooks 2. Pebble Go 3. Tumblebooks 4. ARC-BC 5. Oceanhouse media (apps) 6. Collins Big Cat books (apps) <p>*To take a screenshot photo of the iPad screen click home and on/off at the same time</p>	<p>2</p>	<p>Open Book Creator app Add a new book + New Book Select size for the book</p>  <p>+ Photo find book photo in Camera Roll Tap to select photo to add to Book Creator</p>  <p>Drag corners of photo to get it to the size you would like. Tap and hold photo in Book Creator to lock photo in place.</p>
<p>3</p>	 <p>+ Add Sound record a model fluent reader</p> <p>+ Add Sound record student reader for the book</p> <p>- add a recording on different dates or 1st 2nd and 3rd practice recordings</p> <p>- have the student pick the best one</p> <p>+ Text type the name and date of the reader to put beside the sound icon.</p>	<p>4</p>	 <p>+ Pen mark up book text</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - errors, corrections, strategies used, inflection needed... - try using different colours - student or peer mark up <p>+ Add Sound for a book review of comment</p>

<p>5</p>	<p>Go back to My Books select  to Add a Title and Author</p> 	<p>6</p>	<p>My Books select Sharing icon Export as ePub to read in iBooks PDF to print Video for posting to Kid Blog, ePortfolio or the web</p>
