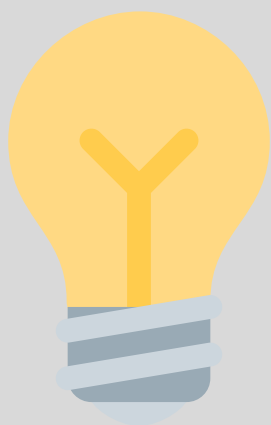


Canada and the Great Depression

1.) WHAT IS AN INFOGRAPHIC?

Infographics are "graphic visual representations of information, data, or knowledge intended to present information quickly and clearly" (Wikipedia).

2.) DETERMINE WHAT PLATFORM YOU WILL USE

4.) DEMONSTRATE YOUR LEARNING

Describe how individual Canadians were impacted by the Great Depression and measures taken to endure the challenges of the decade.

Identify and evaluate federal and provincial government attempts to solve the crisis.

What lessons were learned? What to do and what not to do next time.



5.) CREATE AND BEAUTIFY

Design your Infographic - consult the marking rubric as you build your assignment.

Keep the following questions in mind:

From a distance do I know what your infographic is about?

Does it draw me in to read?

Is it concise and user friendly?
