- Reflection Questions -**

Each of the following questions is intended for you think deeply and generate well thought-out responses.

1. When was the first time in the story that the author gives you the indication that Meg was blind?

2. Explain why think that the author continually hints at Meg being blind throughout the story and doesn’t simply let the reader know from the very beginning.

3. What are some of the emotions Meg experiences throughout the story? Find evidence from the story to support each of your answers. (2-3 examples)

4. Describe the various ways people interact with, or treat, Meg. Find evidence from the story to support each of your answers. (2-3 examples)

5. What is the biggest “dilemma” Meg is facing at school? Explain your answer.

6. What is the importance of the line at the end of the story when Meg tells her mother that she was glad she was at school and says to herself, “There was a lot I wasn’t telling her, but that much, at least, was true”?
