- include an accurate and appropriate visual
- briefly explain the event
- briefly explain why it is significant to Canada's History

- 1497 – “New found land” is discovered and claimed for England
- 1534 – Jacques Cartier travels into Canada
- 1608 – Colony of Quebec is established
- 1670 – Creation of the Hudson's Bay Company
- 1756-63 – Seven Years War (French and Indian Wars)
- 1759 – Battle of the Plains of Abraham
- 1763 – New France is given over to Britain
- 1783 – Loyalists begin to immigrate to Canada after the American Revolution
- 1812 - 1814 – War of 1812
- 1837-38 – Rebellions in Upper/Lower Canada
- 1857-1870 – Gold Rush in BC
- 1867 – Confederation
- 1870 – Red River Resistance and Manitoba
- 1871 – BC joins Canada
- 1873 – PEI joins Canada
- 1876 – Indian Act
- 1885 – North-West Rebellion
- 1885 – Completion of CPR
- 1905 – The provinces of Alberta and Saskatchewan are created
