- Students broke into table groups to discuss what did and didn't go well with the world café.
- **Student thoughts and opinions:**
 - Engaging
 - People were interested the whole time
 - Could be more organized and have a better system than the sticky notes
 - The questions were thorough, but it felt a bit rushed
 - A lot of good discussion, although there wasn't much mixing in-between tables to share opinions.
 - Not much interaction between different schools (middle and high schools)
 - Better advertising for the event and SLC in general would have been better
 - More interactive, perhaps include different stations instead of stationary discussion?
 - Potentially a workshop version of the event?
 - Questions could have been given out ahead of time so that we can brainstorm beforehand.
 - Students didn't really know what they were going into in regards to what a world café is.
 - Smaller events like this but more often (once a month in schools?)
 - Pairing off with a friend for a more comfortable discussion environment.
 - Sign in could have been more organized; more volunteers would have helped.
 - Make our brochures more easily available.
