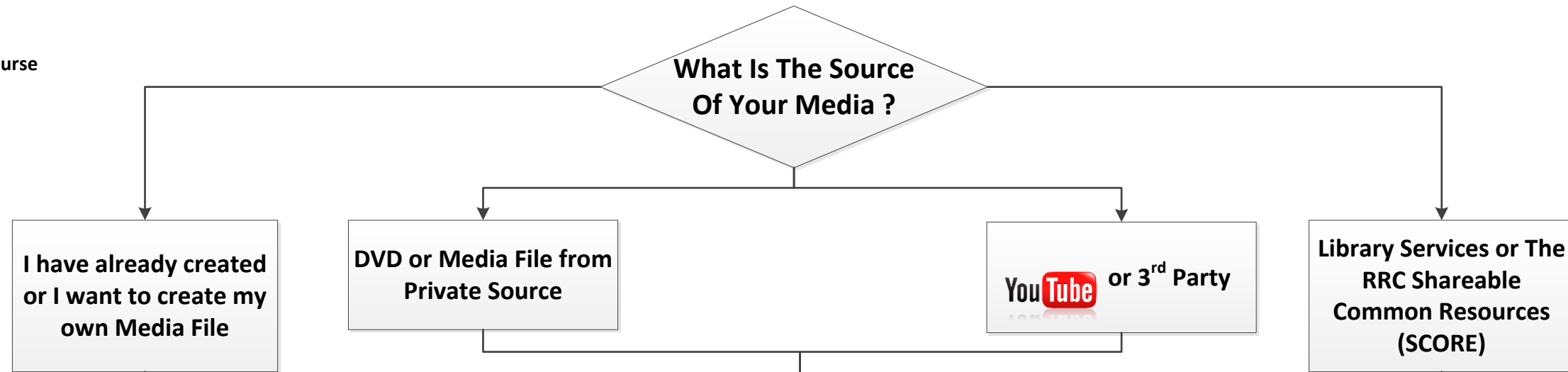


I Want To Upload Media Files Into My LEARN Course

This Flow Chart debates about what is the right way to use media files from different resources

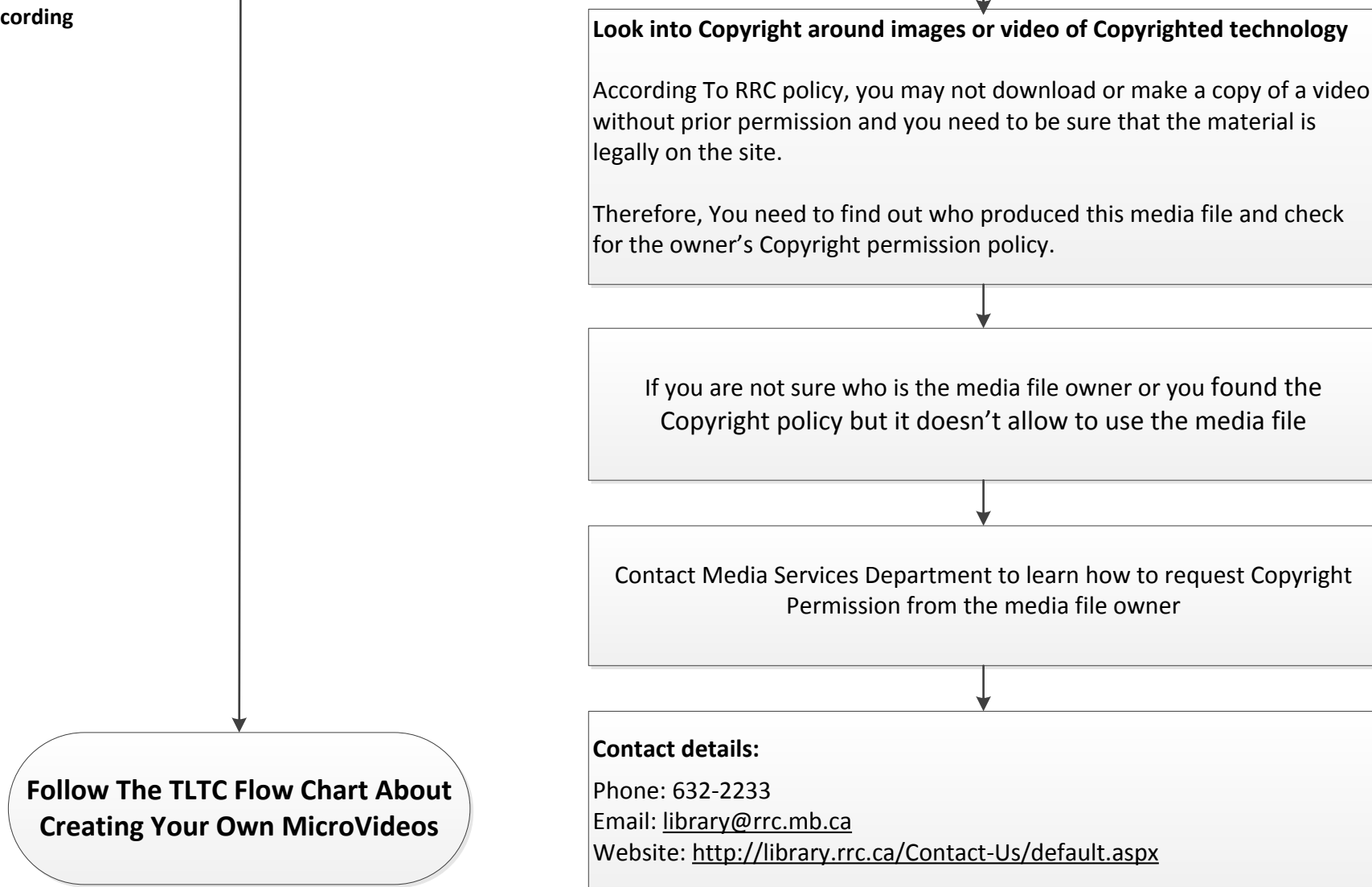
Step 1:

Choose your Media File's Source



Step 2:

Your next actions according to your source



Important To Know!

Each site is different and you should check for information on what is permitted. Just because a video is on a site doesn't mean that it's OK to use. Much of YouTube is illegal. Even though you find something that's openly and legally accessible – e.g. videos on CBC's Learn site – it may not be legal to show them in class.

For group showings like that, it is necessary in Canada to have Public Performance Rights (PPR) so you must check the fine print on the host site to see if those rights have been included.
