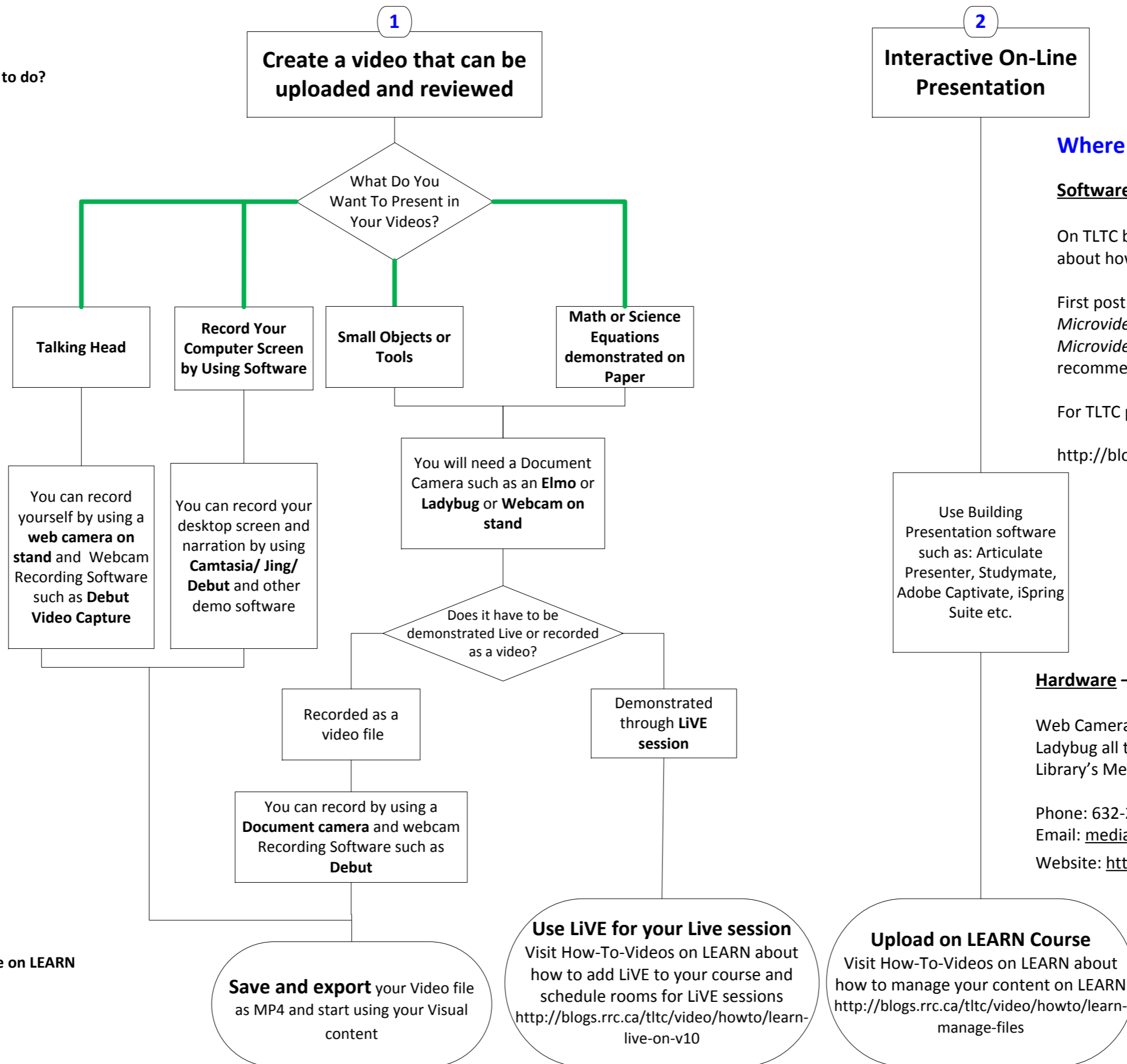


# Create Visual Content For My Course – DIY Guide

**Step 1:**
