Meal Plan (\$201 - \$500)

Meal Plans are available to any RRC Student Resident living in Paterson GlobalFoods Institute (PGI) for 30 or more consecutive days on an optional basis during the Fall or Winter terms. Residents may choose to have a Meal Plan placed on their student card for any value between \$201 - \$500.

- Meal Plans work on a declining debit system and are only activated after payment of full value.
- Meal Plans can be used at any RRC Food Services location on campus; however, alcohol purchases and RED Cards may not be purchased with the Meal Plan.
- Extra money can be added to the Meal Plan at any time by contacting the Campus Living office.
- Meal Plan Cards have real value; the Resident, is responsible to ensure its safety. Lost cards must be reported immediately to the Campus Living Office. Lost cards will be deactivated and replaced at an additional fee of \$25.
- Residents are responsible for any unauthorized purchases made prior to deactivation. Found Meal Plan Cards should be returned to the Campus Living Office.
- Altering a Meal Plan Card in any way may prevent it from functioning, and it will need to be replaced by the Campus Living Office at an additional fee of \$25.

Any unused Meal Plan dollars at the end of the Fall term can be rolled over and added to the Winter term's balance. At the end of the Winter term or when a Resident moves out of Residence with no outstanding fees owing and a minimum \$20 balance remaining on the Meal Plan, he/she can apply to have the unused dollars transferred onto a RED Card (Red River College Food Services Taxable Gift Card) which has no expiry date. RED Card applications must be received within 30 days of the Residence Contract end date or the balance is forfeited to the College.

MEAL PLAN TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Meal Plans are non-transferable, non-interchangeable, and may only be used by the Meal Plan subscriber.
- A Resident must present his/her Meal Plan card to the cashier for every purchase.
- Every RRC Student Resident living in Paterson GlobalFoods Institute (PGI) for 30 or more consecutive days during the Fall or Winter terms may choose to have a Meal Plan added to their account, and placed on their student card for any value between \$201 - \$500.
- Residents cannot transfer funds to another Resident's Meal Plan Card; Meal Plan Card balances cannot be used to pay other Red River College fees.
- Red River College Food Services reserves the right to make occasional adjustments to meal times and locations. Meal Plans are not available during the December winter break (Dec. 16, 2018 - Jan. 1, 2019) or the Spring 2019 term (due to periodic Food Services closures).
- All requests to change Meal Plans must be made within 30 days of the Residence Contract start date. To add to the Meal Plan, Residents are responsible for the cost of the additional dollars. To downgrade the Meal Plan, Residents are responsible for Meal Plan dollars already spent and are subject to a fee of \$25.
- All requests for Meal Plan cancellations and approvals must be made to the Campus Living Office. All approved Contract cancellations are charged a \$25 buyout fee and are subject to cancellation policies.
- Medical needs or religious requirements that may alter the terms of the Meal Plan contract must be presented to the Campus Living Office for evaluation. All requests must be accompanied by satisfactory documentation. If a Contract is cancelled because of a medical need (verified by a physician) the buyout fee is waived.

- Campus Living collects certain personal information from Meal Plan subscribers and is committed to protecting that information as required by law. Personal information collected will be used for the following purposes:
 - Administration of the Meal Plan;
 - Assessing the Meal Plan options;
 - Communication with Residents regarding the Meal Plan.

If you wish to select a Meal Plan for any amount between \$201 - 500 please complete this contract and bring it to the Campus Living Office for activation and payment.

You may also choose the following:

RED CARD (\$20 - \$200)

Any Resident may purchase a RED Card (Red River College Food Services taxable gift card with no expiry date), in person from any Food Services Cashier for values between \$20 - \$200 dollars.

- RED Cards operate on a declining debit system and are only activated after payment of full value.
- RED Cards can be used at any RRC Food Services location on campus, additional RED Cards may not be purchased with a RED Card.
- Extra money can be added to the RED Card at any time.
- RED Cards are to be treated like cash
- RRC is not responsible for the unauthorized use of this card, or for lost or stolen cards. Lost or stolen cards will not be replaced.
