You might expecting the following questions:

What would you like to do in Canada?

Study

How long are you planning to stay in Canada?

Answer according to your situation. Majority of students are looking for an extension of more than 6 months.

Select the code that matches the one on your passport.

Answer according to your situation

What is your current country/territory of residence? If you are presently in Canada, you should select Canada.

Do you have a family member or permanent resident and is 18 years or older?

Answer according to your situation. Family member is defined as a spouse or common-law partner, dependent children, and their dependent children.

What is your date of birth?

Answer according to your situation.

Are you a lawful permanent resident of the United States with a valid alien registration card (Green Card)?

Answer according to your situation.

What is your current immigration status in Canada?


What is your marital status?

Do you also want to apply for a work permit?

Answer according to your situation. If you are applying for Co-Op work permit while you are applying the study permit extension, you can choose “Yes, I wish to apply for a CoOp Work Permit”.

When does your status in Canada expire?

Answer according to your situation. (You need a valid study permit at the time of application)

Have you had a medical exam performed by an IRCC authorized panel physician (doctor) within the last 12 months?

Answer according to your situation.

Have you lived in a designated country or territory for more than six months in the last year? (Or you can understand as “Have you live outside of Canada for more than six months in the last year?”)

Answer according to your situation.

Do you want to submit an application for a family member?

Answer according to your situation. You might expecting more questions if you answer “Yes”.
