DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair, Applied Computer Education, the Instructor is required to teach Networking courses to first and second year students. The incumbent will be expected to develop and modify curriculum; conduct student assessment and counseling; supervise student practical labs; maintain lab and classroom equipment; maintain accurate program records; effectively manage classroom activities; and perform related administrative responsibilities as required.
