DUTIES

Reporting to the Program Manager in the School of Continuing Education, the instructor is required to deliver theoretical and practical training to students in the 5th Class Power Engineering Technology program. Duties will include but not be limited to: development and modification of curriculum; conducting student assessments and counselling; supervise students' practical labs; maintain lab and classroom equipment; maintain accurate program records; effectively manage classroom activities and perform related administrative responsibilities as required. The incumbent is also required to participate in department and college committees and assist in student orientation and graduation activities.
