DUTIES

Reporting to the Chair of the Electrical, Mechanical and Manufacturing department, the Instructor is required to deliver theory and practical training to welding students, develop and modify curriculum, conduct student assessments and provide academic counselling, supervise student practical labs, maintain lab and classroom equipment, maintain accurate program reports, effectively manage classroom activities, and perform related administrative responsibilities as required.
